99.5% Holy Cross pass rate for A Levels in 2020.

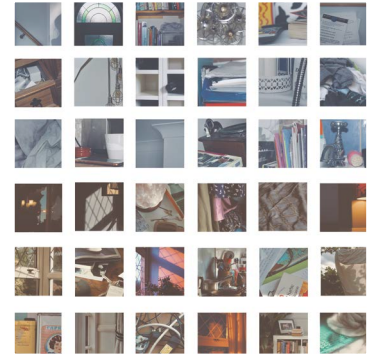
100% Holy Cross pass rate for L3 BTECs in 2020.

Applying to Holy Cross

Below are a few frequently asked questions to help you with your application. If you would like any further information please email our Admissions Team at admissions@holycross.ac.uk

What are the entry requirements?

To study 3 A Levels/L3 BTECs - 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including either Maths or an English GCSE. The entry requirements to start 4 are significantly higher than for 3 (please see the college website for further details www.holycross.ac.uk).

What is Holy Cross looking for from an application?

The 'Personal Statement' section is seen by the College to be very important and students are encouraged to take time completing this. This will be read before an interview is held and staff will want to explore the ideas in the application with the student.

How many subjects can I apply for?

The vast majority of students now take 3 subjects at advanced level. You can add a 4th subject as a 'reserve' subject if you wish.

Can I change my choices?

It is important to stress that subject choices made on completion of the application are not set in stone. Indeed, we often see changes made at various stages of the application process as students become more informed about their choices and we welcome discussions about such requests.
