Dear Student

I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for your GCSE results day on the 12th August 2021.

Your results will be available from 10.30am on the 12th August and you are to enter school through the main reception.

Due to the unprecedented situation, we are in this year, the appeal processes exam boards usually offer to students, such as Clerical Rechecks, Review of Marking and Copy of Scripts, will not be in place this year. Instead Ofqual have confirmed the following details about appealing calculated grades this summer:

1. If a student believes there was an error in the way we followed or applied the procedure for determining our student's grade.
2. If they feel we did not make a reasonable judgment when deciding which evidence to use to determine the student's grade.
3. If they feel we did not make a reasonable judgment about the students' grade based on the evidence gathered.
